## VENUES :

↪ Saturday and Sunday : Dubus and Beaumont sports halls : 12 courts

## CATEGORIES :

- U 12 - born in 2014 and before
- U 13 - born in 2013 & 2012
- U 15 - born in 2011 & 2010
- U 17 & U19 - born in 2009, 2008, 2007 & 2006

Foreigners (outside France) have to play in their age category (French regulation applies)  
ex : for instance a player born in 2011 "Benjamin" in Belgium will play in U15 "Minime" in France.

Players born in 2014 are authorized to play in U13 category.

It is accepted to play on the immediately upper (older) category

↪ Saturday : Men's singles & Women's singles (including finals)

↪ Sunday : Men's doubles & Women's doubles

## EVENTS :

- ↪ Each player can play on both events.
- ↪ For each event the first round will be played in groups and the following rounds will be played according to the knock-out system.
- ↪ Preferably 2 players/pairs exit from groups of 4 to the following round.



**NUMBER OF PLAYERS PER EVENT** : The number of players is determined in the following order :

- maximum number as per hereunder table
- priority given to the players having higher ranking
- and if necessary, order of inscription on badnet (French) or by e-mail (foreigners)

U 12 :	➤ MS 20 players ➤ MD 16 pairs	➤ WS 12 players ➤ WD 12 pairs
U 13 :	➤ MS 24 players ➤ MD 16 pairs	➤ WS 16 players ➤ DD 12 pairs
U 15 :	➤ MS 32 players ➤ MD 24 pairs	➤ WS 24 players ➤ WD 16 pairs
U 17 & U 19 : High Ranking	➤ MS 20 players ➤ MD 16 pairs	➤ WS 12 players ➤ WD 12 pairs
U 17 & U 19 : Middle Ranking	➤ MS 20 players ➤ MD 16 pairs	➤ WS 12 players ➤ WD 12 pairs
U 17 & U 19 : Low Ranking	➤ MS 20 players ➤ MD 16 pairs	➤ WS 12 players ➤ WD 12 pairs

According to the number of registrations the number of players may be modified, with a maximum of 32 players / pairs per event in order to respect French regulations.

"x16 rule (French regulation)" In the same event the best ranked player's number of points cannot exceed 16 times the lowest ranked player's number of points. For instance if the lowest ranked player's number of points is 8 then the event cannot include players with more than 128 points. Exceptions : if an event includes at least one non ranked or P12 ranked player then it can include at maximum D7 ranked players (< 64 points) for U 12 - U 13 - U 15, D8 ranked players (< 32 points) for U 17 and U 19. This rule will be applied, taking into consideration that priority is given to the players having more points

#### UNDER 18 YEARS OLD PLAYERS :

Each under 18 years old player to the tournament must be placed, explicitly and permanently, under the responsibility of a responsible adult, known to the referee, and having a written agreement from the parents (French regulation). Please fill completely the registration sheet.



## SCHEDULE :

⇒ Beginning of matches is scheduled at 8.00 each day. Last match is started at 20.00.  
Players must be present 1 hour before the beginning of the matches (30 mns for first matches of each day)

## REGISTRATION AND FEES :

- ⇒ The fees are 12 € for one event, 16 € for two events.
- ⇒ French players : registration and payment shall be done on badnet website. Foreigners : please ask and send the filled registration sheet to Pascal DEGRUGILLIER : [pascal.degrugillier@gmx.fr](mailto:pascal.degrugillier@gmx.fr). Payment by bank transfer. No registration by phone accepted.
- ⇒ The number of players is limited, registrations shall be booked, by categories, by number of points and then if necessary by chronological order of registration on badnet (e-mail for foreigners). Priority is given to the players having higher ranking.
- ⇒ Register until : 25<sup>th</sup> January 2024
- ⇒ Draw on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024
- ⇒ Ranking on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2024 are considered for the draw

- ⇒ Homologated FFBAD feather shuttlecocks to be shared between players until semi-finals, included.
- ⇒ Shuttlecocks will be supplied for the finals.
- ⇒ In case of discussion the reference shuttlecock sold inside the hall is : YONEX AS 20.

## RECOMPENSES :

- ⇒ In every event there will be prizes for the winner and the runner-up.

## **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS :**

- ✉ Entitled to take part are players who are members of a Badminton Federation associated with the BWF. In the limit conditions of article 6.7 of French regulation, licensed players from other European countries can compete. (For those a checking will be performed on internet before the draw. If not a written commitment shall be completed before the start of the competition. The stranger players are deemed to respect the French federal regulations during the competition, especially concerning age categories, behaviour, attitude and clothing).
  - ✉ Proposed events are women's and men's singles, women's and men's doubles. Categories are U12, U13, U15, U17 and U19
  - ✉ Any player can register for both events. He/she can register in different categories for each event.
  - ✉ Any player can register in the immediately superior category. According to article 3.2.1.5 of French regulation, the number of points of the highest ranked player of the event cannot be more than 16 times superior to the lowest ranked player number of points. If it occurs the lowest ranked player shall not be retained for the competition.
  - ✉ According to the French regulation, organisation may split one event, separation will then be processed by decreasing number of points.
  - ✉ The tournament management reserves the right to merge age categories events with referee agreement.
  - ✉ The displayed groups are informative and may be modified until the beginning of matches.
  - ✉ The matches order respects as much as possible the initial scheduled sequence.
  - ✉ No fees shall be reimbursed if the walk-over is not medically justified and not signalled before the draw.
  - ✉ After the draw, in case of walk-over of a player from a pair, his/her partner shall inform by e-mail the referee ([brigitte.demoncourt@gmail.com](mailto:brigitte.demoncourt@gmail.com)) either the name of his/her new partner, or his/her own cancellation of registration to the doubles event; the voluntary walk-over will be appreciated by the referee.  
The walk-overs shall be justified in maximum 5 days after the competition to the regional referee commission: [crabadhf@gmail.com](mailto:crabadhf@gmail.com)
  - ✉ As soon as they arrive in the sports hall, the participants players have to give notice of their presence at the tournament organisation table.
  - ✉ The players may be called to play their match as soon as their convocation hour.
  - ✉ All players must have a federal licence at the date of the draw, and must not be suspended.
  - ✉ Any player non present on the court after 3<sup>rd</sup> call of his/her name will be declared walk-over by the referee.
  - ✉ Warm-up time will be 3 minutes from match announcement by the organisation table (including test of shuttlecocks and clothing).
  - ✉ The players must come to the designated court with all necessary accessories for their match. It is not allowed to leave the court before the end of the match.
  - ✉ Any player having to leave the sports hall must inform the referee, otherwise he/she can be disqualified at the call of his/her match or at the beginning of it.
  - ✉ Only homologated shuttlecocks are authorised, in case of disagreement the reference shuttlecock will be for sale inside the hall.
  - ✉ All matches will be played in to winning games (21 points each) according the regulations in force.
  - ✉ The rest time between two matches is 20 minutes (end of last point to beginning of first point)
  - ✉ 2 players (singles) and 2 pairs (doubles) will be qualified out of groups of 3 preferably.
  - ✉ Until the semi-finals (included) the matches will be played in self-arbitration, an umpire will be available anytime inside the hall. The umpire will be designated by the referee for the matches where his/her presence will be necessary.
  - ✉ If the shuttlecock touches the cables or the basketball pole will be let at serve, fault during the play.
  - ✉ Clothing must comply with badminton regulations.
  - ✉ The referee may disqualify any player who does not respect the regulation. The licensed player getting a black card will get from the referee a paper form explaining the procedures and sanctions to which the player exposes himself/herself, according to the French regulation. All decision from the referees is without discussion.

- ✉ Rules are according French Badminton Federation Official regulations, 2022 edition. Any substance or way of artificially improve performance for competitions and that may injure ethics, physical and psychic integrity of player, is prohibited. The list of doping substances is made official by French ministry of sports (article 10 of medical regulation from badminton guide). Any player in possession of a medical prescription for sports doping medication must inform the referee before his/her first match.
  - ✉ Present regulation will be displayed inside the halls all competition long. Participation implies agreement of this regulation.
  - ✉ The organisation decline all responsibility in case of thefts, loss, accident or incidents.
