



Postdoctoral fellowship offer

Elaboration and multi-criteria comparison of silvicultural scenarios taking into account risks and uncertainties associated with climate change

The Forest Resources Management Unit of the University of Liege - Gembloux Agro-Bio Tech is recruiting a post-doctoral researcher in forestry to develop its research in the framework of the Rege+ project. The fellowship offer is open to PhDs in an international mobility situation.

Job description

Contrasting silvicultural itineraries will be tested by simulation for <u>different study cases</u> and different climate scenarios. The candidate will have to :

- ✓ Participate in the monitoring of field experiments;
- ✓ Model the growth of oak and beech young trees;
- ✓ Participate in the development of a simulation plan to compare different regeneration methods;
- ✓ Calculate indicators of regeneration development, diversity, profitability and resilience;
- ✓ Perform a multi-criteria comparison of the simulated scenarios;
- ✓ Write and publish a synthesis of the results;
- ✓ Write a literature review on methods to evaluate the economic interest of simulated silvicultural itineraries taking into account risks and uncertainties.

Profile

- ✓ Master's degree in environmental science.
- ✓ PhD degree obtained within the last 10 years.
- ✓ The candidate must not have resided or exercised his/her main activity (employment, studies, etc.) in Belgium for more than 24 months during the last 3 years. Short stays such as vacations, participation in conferences/symposiums are not taken into account.
- ✓ Extensive knowledge of forestry.
- ✓ Extensive knowledge of data management and statistical analysis (modeling).
- ✓ Ability to work in a team.

The activities will take place within the ForestlsLife research team, on the Gembloux Agro-Bio Tech site but travel to Louvain-la-Neuve (UCLouvain) will be frequent. The expected start date will be between September 1, 2023 and January 1, 2024. The duration of the commitment is 14 months.
