



HSHF was established in 1982 to assure that funds would be available to support continuing education through an annual HSHA conference. In early 1998, HSHF was incorporated as a non-profit organization to support the advancement of knowledge and the improvement of the clinical practice of Speech Language Pathology and Audiology.

HSHF is non-profit and non-political. Contributions to HSHF are used to meet HSHF's stated educational purposes such as supporting HSHA's annual conventions, supplementing presenters or honorariums, travel expenses offering student scholarships, awarding continuing education grants for groups and individuals, and offering grants or loans to members to support research. HSHF has supported a vairety of activities since it was first incorporated including establishing a loan bank for assitive technology devices and starting an educational materials lending library.
