Mass Ave Indy Events and Opportunities

- ❖ Community Socials, First Fridays in June, August and September, 5 PM − 8 PM; hosted on the roof deck of the Marietta Building. Join us to mingle with residents, donors and other business owners. Showcase your business by donating a gift card, food or drinks.
- Mass Ave Clean Ups, volunteer or sponsor one or both spring & fall Mass Ave clean ups. We pick up trash, weed landscape beds, and paint the curbs in our logo colors. Averaging 60-people twice a year. Provide a gift card, food, drink, or other volunteer thank you.
- ❖ Sidewalk Sale, last Saturday in July in coordination with Bottleworks Vendor Day. All Mass Ave businesses invited to participate. Have a presence outside on the sidewalk support your fellow businesses, sell discounted merchandise, or offer tastes, meal deals.
- ❖ Mass Ave Mile Summerfest, last Sunday in July. Mass Ave closes a selected block for a street festival. Features local performers, buskers, and artist/maker booths in the street. Sponsorships available. Share your swag at the Mass Ave booth.
- ❖ Monster Mash: Sunday before Halloween. Based on a 60's hit song and a 1995 movie associated with Frankenstein's Monster, a creature shunned by society as "other", Monster Mash on Mass Ave invites you to mask-up and welcome the others among us for a fun night at the intersection of arts, culture and commerce.
- ❖ Midnight Shopper, 3rd Friday in November. Calling all night owl shoppers to enjoy an evening out with friends on Mass Ave. Participating businesses are up WAY past their bedtimes and are offering deals, discounts or donating profits to local charitable organizations. Find gifts in home décor, pet supplies, clothing, accessories, beauty, wine, artwork, sweet treats, locally crafted artisanal products, and more. Sip a hot cider or chocolate from participating restaurants to keep you warm on your trek.
- ❖ Small Business Saturday, Saturday after Thanksgiving. Small Business Saturday is a day dedicated to strengthening the community by supporting small independent businesses. As a way of saying "thank you" for the year-round support, the Merchants of Mass Ave give away gifts and prizes by handing out Shop Small Swag Bags to the first 10 customers of the day.
