#### Create a link between the bureau and all presidents

#### **Defend clubs' interests**

- Make sure that HPSU projects respect clubs' interests and clubs keep their freedom to enter partnerships
- Help negotiate corporate partnerships for clubs

### Increase reach and awareness of the HPSU and their projects

- Inform all students directly or via their presidents about HPSU projects
- Recruit new clubs to maximize the impact of the HPSU as an umbrella organization

### Develop projects with the bureau

- Create an efficient tool for relaying to the administration students' stances
- Create synergies between MBA's clubs, International students' clubs and Grande Ecole program students' clubs



# **HPSU Support to Associations – our Projects**

- 1. Support clubs with legal & tax compliance
- 2. Maintain a calendar in which the semester plan of all programs can be seen (facilitates the timing and organization of events)
- 3. A blocked time every week in schedule of every student for club activities
- 4. Search and provide storage space to clubs
- 5. Introduce Co-Working Spaces for clubs in the B1 Building
- 6. Increase collaboration between clubs
- 7. Provide a clear overview of funding sources for clubs at HEC Paris. Make the process of funding applications more transparent.
- 8. Share best practices on how to acquire external sponsors and on how to formulate partnership agreements.


